- **Early check-in**-Saturday after 1:00 p.m until 6:00 p.m. **When you reserve stalls, please mention if you will be arriving later than 6:00 p.m.** on the 21st.
- **Day of show**-Please be at the fairgrounds Sunday morning no later than 6:30 a.m. to get parked. You may pick up your show packet starting at 7:00 a.m. in the Show Office. Look for a sign that says **DRAFT HORSE CHECK-IN**, on the southeast end of the arena, separate building by the maintenance garage.
- **Please register as early as possible!** Late entries will be \$15.00 per performance class. We expect to follow the schedule in this packet. We reserve the right to cancel a class with no entries.
- **Exhibitor numbers**-In your **entry** packet, you will find your exhibitor numbers. Each number will be labeled with the class/classes to which the number belongs. Please be sure to use the correct number for the proper class and display the number so it can be easily seen by the judge and ring steward.
- **Class times**-You are responsible to be at the gate prior to the start of your class. We reserve the right to close the class for late arrivals. We will have a rover with a portable public address system to notify you of upcoming classes. **Please be ready!**
- **Parking area**-There are many events at the fairgrounds August 21st and 22nd. A special parking area has been designated for the Draft Horse Show on the south side of the fairgrounds property. Please avoid entering the fairgrounds from the east, off of Community Drive. Traffic from Hwy 36, enter the fairgrounds from 4th Street on the West end of the fairgrounds, or from Manford Avenue, between the stockades, on the south side. There will be someone there to direct you to the parking and unloading area. The area will be restricted to the Draft Horse Show, however please use caution as you move your horses between classes. Multiple hitches should use walkers to and from the arena to alert others to your progress.

This waiver includes any claims, damage, or injury as a result of any negligence and/or breach of warranty against the Town of Estes Park, Colorado, its officers, employees, agents, volunteers, and self insurance pool for any and all injuries incurred in said activities. The undersigned also assumes the risk and waives any claim for personal property damage, including damage to any horse owned or under control of the undersigned for any injuries suffered by said horse in the activities at The Fairgrounds at Stanley Park.

The terms of this Release shall serve as a Release and assumption of risk for any heirs, personal representatives and administrators.
